

PUBLIC INFO MEETING IS SEPT. 27 FOR SASHABAW PAVING, SHERWOOD TO GRANGER

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Brandon Township, will host a public information meeting Sept. 27 to share information about the planned 2019 paving of Sashabaw Road between from Sherwood Road to Granger Road.

MEETING DETAILS


WHAT: Public information meeting to discuss the construction plans and the impact on traffic during construction.

WHEN: Thursday, Sept. 27, 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.

WHERE: Brandon Middle School, 609 S. Ortonville Road, Brandon Township, MI 48462

NOTE: The meeting will be “open house” format.

There will not be a formal presentation. Anyone can attend any time between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. to review information and speak with an RCOC representative.



PROJECT DETAILS

The project will involve paving the one-mile gravel section of Sashabaw Road from Sherwood Road to Granger Road. It will include some paved shoulders, placement of some curbs and gutters, storm sewer installation and drainage improvements.

SCHEDULE AND IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

The project is expected to start in summer 2019 and be completed in the fall of 2019.

The road will be closed to through traffic during construction. Access to all homes and businesses on the road will be maintained at all times.

The detour route for through traffic will be Sherwood Road to Perry Lake Road to Granger Road, back to Sashabaw Road and vice versa.

Due to the presence of a species of protected bats in the area, tree removal required for the project is planned to take place during the winter prior to the start of construction.

FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$2.2 million. Eighty percent of the project cost will be paid for with federal road funding. The remaining portion will be shared by RCOC, Brandon Twp. and Oakland County general government through the Tri-Party Program.
