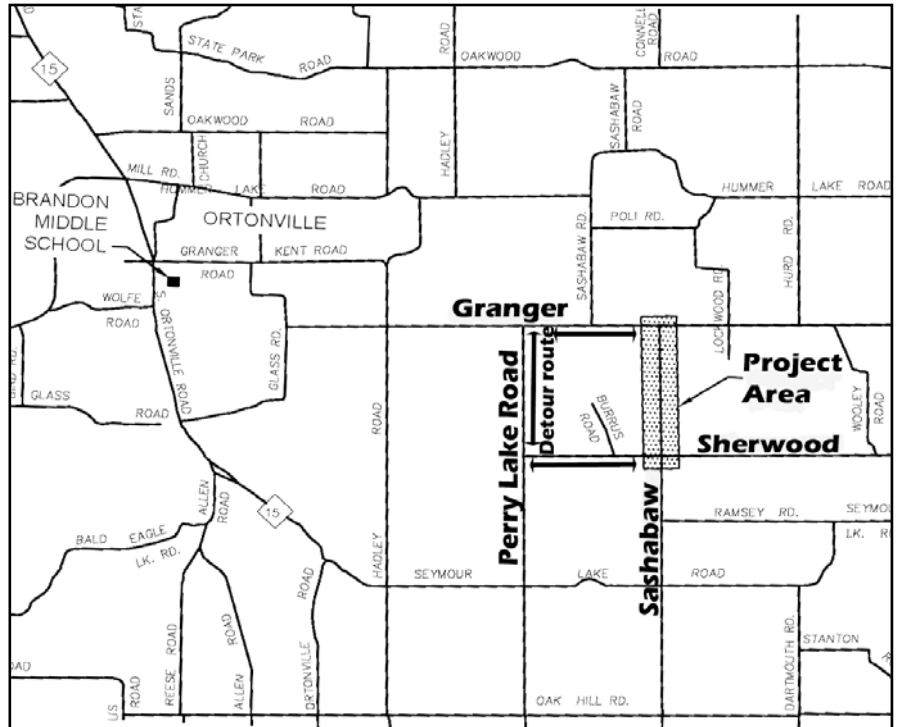


SASHABAW PAVING, SHERWOOD TO GRANGER, TO BEGIN IN JUNE

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Brandon Township, will pave the gravel section of Sashabaw Road from Sherwood Road to Granger Road this summer, requiring the closure of the road during construction.



PROJECT DETAILS

The project will involve paving this one-mile gravel section of Sashabaw Road. It will include some paved shoulders, placement of some curbs and gutters, storm sewer installation and drainage improvements.

Schedule and IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

The project is expected to start in June 2019 and be completed in the fall of 2019.

The road will be closed to through traffic during construction. Access to all homes and businesses on the road will be maintained at all times.

The detour route for through traffic will be Sherwood Road to Perry Lake Road to Granger Road and vice versa.

FUNDING

The project is expected to cost approximately \$3.2 million. Eighty percent of the project cost will be paid for with federal road funding. The remaining portion will be shared by RCOC, Brandon Twp. and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).

CONTRACTOR

Zito Construction, of Grand Blanc, is the contractor for the project.
