

## RCOC TO REPLACE CONCRETE SLABS ON SECTIONS OF BIG BEAVER, DEQUINDRE, MAPLE, JOHN R AND LIVERNOIS ROADS IN TROY

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the City of Troy, will replace concrete slabs on sections of Big Beaver, Dequindre, Maple, John R and Livernois roads in Troy.

### **PROJECT DETAILS**

The project will include removal and replacement of concrete slabs on the following road segments:

- Big Beaver: I-75 to Livernois
- Big Beaver: Rochester to Dequindre
- Dequindre: Big Beaver to Long Lake
- Maple: At John R intersection — eastbound center left-turn lane only
- John R: Maple to Long Lake
- Livernois: North of Wattles to south of Long Lake

### **SCHEDULE**

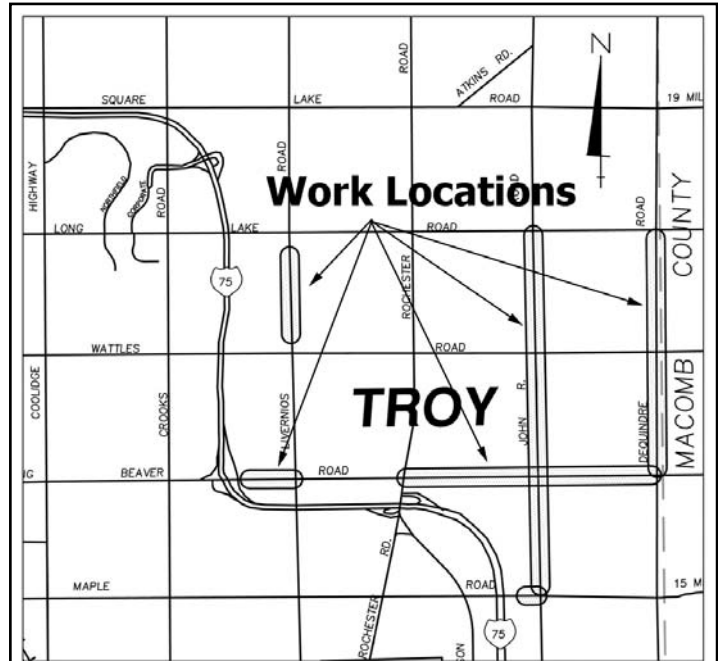
Work began in May and be completed in fall.

### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

The work will be done in three stages:

**Stage 1:** Westbound Big Beaver is reduced to one lane from west of Livernois to Dequindre while concrete slabs are replaced in two lanes. The intersections of Rochester and Big Beaver and Dequindre and Big Beaver will both be reduced to one lane in each direction for slab replacement as well. Dequindre between Big Beaver and Long Lake and John R between Maple and Wattles will also be reduced to one lane in each direction. This stage is expected to be completed by early July.

**Stage 2:** Upon completion of Stage 1, eastbound Big Beaver will be reduced to one lane between Rochester and Dequindre, as will John R between Wattles and Long Lake. This stage



will also include work on eastbound Maple Road at John R and at Livernois; and John R between Wattles and Long Lake. This stage is expected to be completed in the fall.

### **PROJECT COST AND FUNDING**

The project is expected to cost \$5 million. Eighty percent of the cost will be paid for with federal funds. The remainder will be shared by RCOC, Troy and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
