



PERMIT APPLICATION FEES AS OF JANUARY 1, 2007

Each item listed below should be a separate application. Many projects will have more than one permit required – one for approach and related work and another for underground utility connections. Please direct any questions to (248) 858-4835 or permits@rcoc.org.

Please include 3 sets of plans with each application.

Paving/Approach Work: Application Fee

New approach(es) and path along site frontage	\$200
Remove and replace or repair existing approach	\$100
New safety path only (no approach)	\$100
Utility driveway (to outbuilding or uncultivated land)	\$40

Landscaping:

Planting, berms, grading, drainage work, entrance markers	\$100
Tree removal or planting only	\$0

Underground Utility:

Sanitary and/or water main	\$100
Sanitary and/or water main and storm connection*	\$300
Storm connection only *	\$200
Sump pump connection to enclosed sewer	\$50

*A storm connection is the outlet of on-site storm water to the ROW. It does not include re-routing existing storm due to approach work. Updating existing drainage is included in the approach permit.

Overhead Utility:

New utility poles or add to existing poles	\$100

Miscellaneous:

Soil borings, monitoring wells, and/or groundwater wells	\$100
Seismic testing or geo probe	\$100
New traffic signal or move existing signal	\$700
Special haul routes	\$150
Annual dust control permit	\$0
Surveying in the right-of-way	\$0
Residential driveway	\$60

No Application Fees Are Required For Governmental Organizations (Municipalities, Public School Districts, Public Libraries, etc.)
