

RCOC TO REPLACE CULVERTS UNDER COOLEY LAKE ROAD IN SUMMER OF 2022

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) will replace the two culverts that carry the Huron River under Cooley Lake Road west of Carroll Lake Road on the White Lake Township/Commerce Township border in 2022.

PROJECT DETAILS


The project includes:

- Removing the two existing culverts under Cooley Lake Road and replacing them with a pre-cast concrete bridge.
- Placement of curbs and gutters along Cooley Lake Road in the vicinity of the new bridge.
- Replacement of the guardrails in the vicinity of the new bridge.
- Removal and replacement of the pavement and minor storm sewer improvements in the vicinity of the new bridge.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Cooley Lake Road will be closed to through traffic between Carroll Lake Road and Oxbow Lake Road during the project.

The detour route will be Carroll Lake Road to Wise Road to Bogie Lake Road and back to Cooley Lake Road and vice versa.



SCHEDULE

Work will start in summer 2022, with completion in the fall of 2022.

PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project will cost approximately \$1.8 million and will be paid for with a combination of federal road funds and RCOC dollars.
