

## WALTON BLVD. TO BE RECONSTRUCTED, SASHABAW TO CLINTONVILLE, BEGINNING IN SUMMER

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Waterford Township, will reconstruct Walton Blvd. from Sashabaw Road to Clintonville Road providing a smooth new surface, improved safety and greater accessibility for pedestrians and non-motorized users.

### **PROJECT DETAILS**

The project will include:

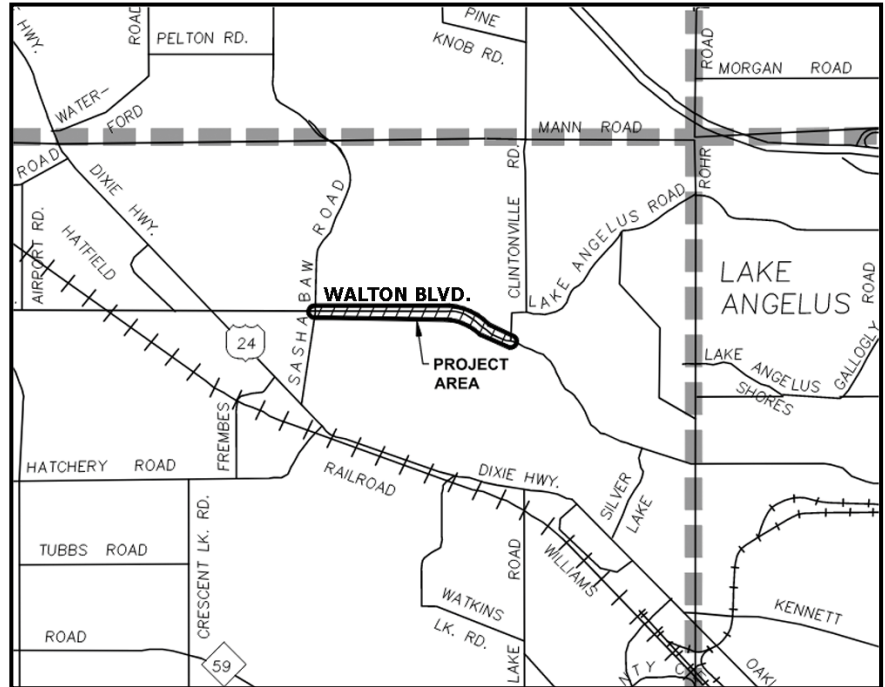
- Removal of existing concrete pavement and repaving the road with asphalt.
- Replacement of some concrete curbs and gutters.
- Replacement of the traffic signal at the drive to Mason Middle School.
- Minor improvements to storm sewers and drainage.
- Upgrades to pedestrian crossings to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).

### **SCHEDULE**

The project is expected to start in summer and be completed in November.

### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

One lane of traffic will remain open in each direction throughout the project. Access will be maintained to all homes and businesses along this section of Walton Blvd. at all times.



### **PROJECT COST AND FUNDING**

The project is expected to cost approximately \$4 million. Eighty percent of the cost will be paid for with federal road funds. The remainder will be shared by RCOC, Waterford Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
