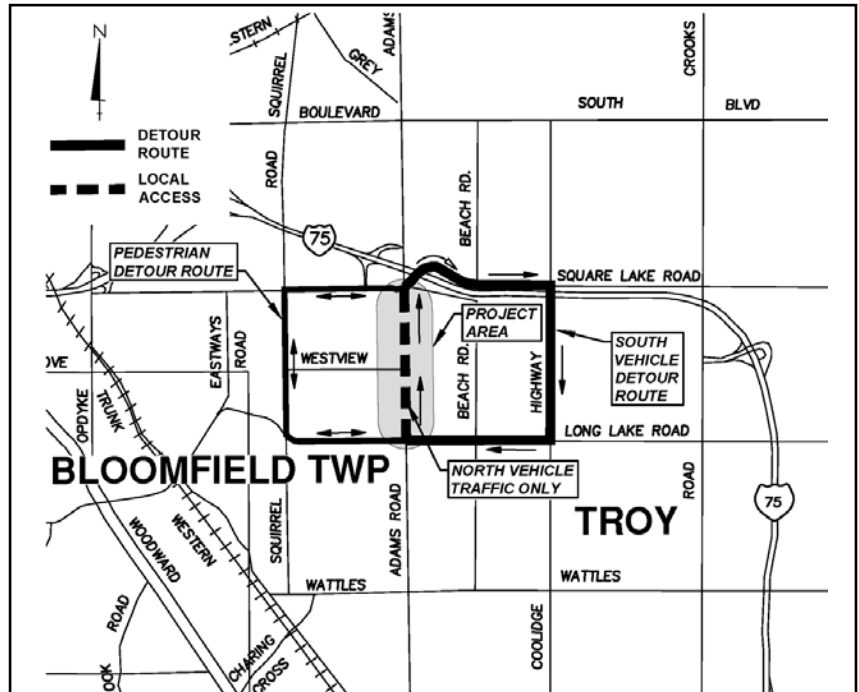


## ADAMS ROAD RESURFACING PROJECT, SQUARE LAKE TO LONG LAKE, WILL RESUME APPROX. APRIL 4

The contractor for the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) expects to resume work on the Adams Road resurfacing project, Square Lake Road to Long Lake Road, on approximately April 4.

### **SUMMARY**

The contractor, Pro Line Asphalt Paving, was unable to complete the project in 2021 in accordance with the contractual schedule. Consequently, Pro Line is returning this year to finish the project.



### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

Once work resumes, **the road will again be closed to southbound traffic**, but **will remain open northbound**.

As was the case last year, the **detour route for southbound traffic** during the closure will be Adams Road to Square Lake Road to Coolidge Highway to Long Lake Road and back to Adams. The **detour route for pedestrians** who would normally use this section of Adams Road will be Adams Road to Long Lake Road to Squirrel Road to Square Lake Road and back to Adams Road and vice versa.

### **SCHEDULE**

Work is expected to be completed by the end of June.

### **PROJECT COST AND FUNDING**

The project is expected to cost \$2.6 million. The cost will be paid for with federal road funds and contributions from RCOC and the City of Troy.
