

## CURRIE ROAD PAVING, EIGHT MILE TO NINE MILE, TO START APRIL 15

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Lyon Township, will begin paving Currie Road between Eight Mile and Nine Mile roads on approximately April 15.

The project will include constructing roundabouts at the Currie Road/Eight Mile Road and Currie Road/Nine Mile Road intersections.

### PROJECT DETAILS

The project will include:

- Asphalt paving of Currie Road from Eight Mile Road to Nine Mile Road (currently gravel) with some concrete curbs and gutters.
- Construction of a single-lane roundabout at the Eight Mile/Currie intersection.
- Construction of a “compact” single-lane roundabout at the Nine Mile/Currie intersection.
- Drainage improvements.
- New traffic signs and pavement markings.

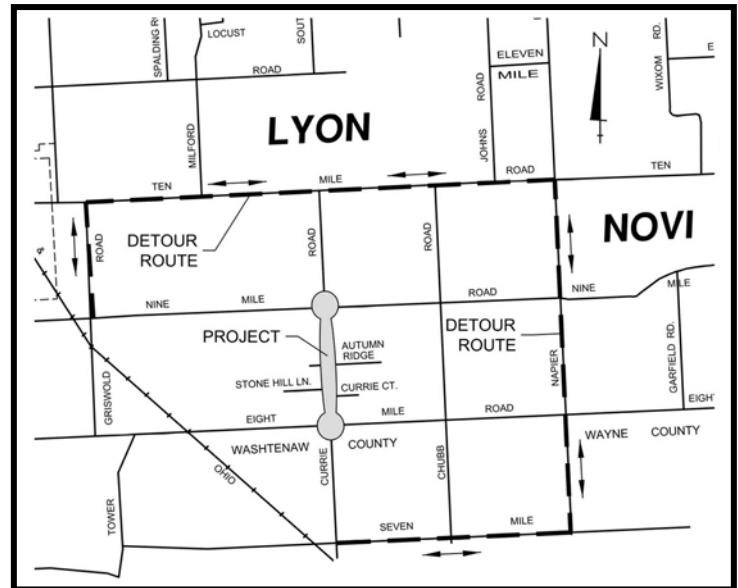
### IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Currie Road **will be closed between Eight Mile Road and Nine Mile Road during construction.** Access to properties along this section of Currie Road will be maintained at all times during the project.

The intersection of Currie Road and Eight Mile will also be closed for the roundabout construction through approximately late June. Once the Eight Mile/Currie intersection opens, the Nine Mile/Currie intersection will close for the construction of the second roundabout.

**The detours for through traffic are:**

- **Currie Road closure:** Seven Mile Road to Napier Road to Ten Mile Road, back to Currie and vice versa.



- Eight Mile traffic during the **Eight Mile/Currie intersection closure:** Eight Mile to Griswold to Ten Mile to Napier and back to Eight Mile.
- Nine Mile traffic during the **Nine Mile/Currie intersection closure:** Nine Mile to Griswold to Ten Mile to Napier and back to Nine Mile.

### FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$4.4 million and will be paid for with federal road funds and matching dollars from RCOC, Lyon Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program). The Washtenaw County Road Commission will contribute funding for the Currie Road/8 Mile Road roundabout.
