

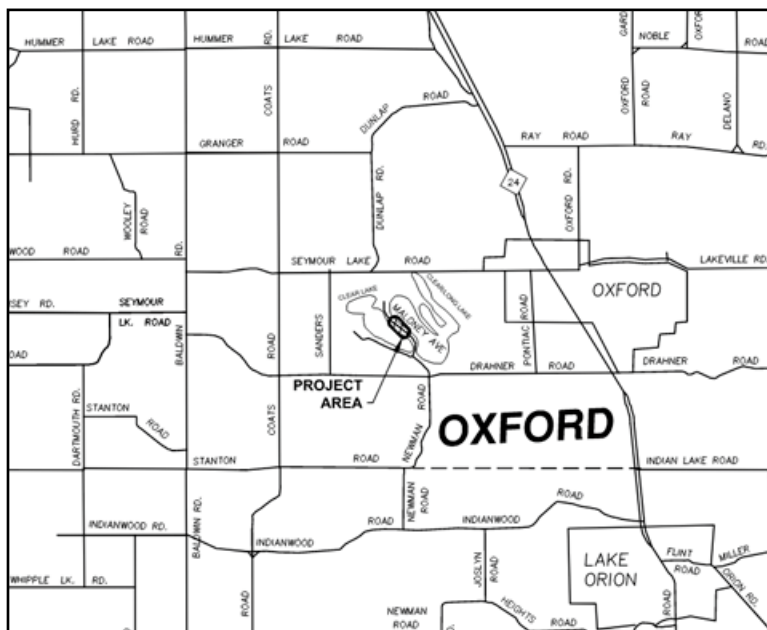
MALONEY AVE. BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT TO START IN JULY

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Oxford Township, will replace the Maloney Avenue bridge over Long Lake/Clear Lake beginning July 5.

PROJECT DETAILS

The project includes:

- Replacement of the Maloney bridge over Long Lake/Clear Lake
- Reconstruction of one-tenth of a mile of Maloney Ave. with asphalt pavement (work will extend 300 feet north and south of bridge)
- Upgrading of guardrails and traffic signs at the bridge.
- Closure of the existing bridge during construction; access to all homes will be maintained via a single-lane temporary road next to the bridge.
- Expect construction traffic between Drahnert Road and the bridge, on Lakeview and Maloney streets, throughout construction. Drivers and pedestrians should use caution throughout the project.



SCHEDULE

- Bridge/waterway closure: July
- Project completion: November

TEMPORARY RESTRICTED LAKE ACCESS

During the project, boats will be prohibited from crossing under the bridge.

PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project is expected to cost \$2.5 million. It is being paid for with federal funds and RCOC dollars.

The contractor for the project is F.H. Paschen of Detroit.
