RE: CALL FOR FEDERAL AID PROJECTS: FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027

Dear Federal Aid Committee Members:

The Oakland County Federal Aid Committee met on September 7, 2022, and issued a call for **Resurfacing, Restoration and Rehabilitation (RRR) projects for fiscal year (FY) 2026 and 2027. Project application submissions are due no later than Friday, December 16, 2022 at 3:00 PM.**

Please note that the RRR Project Activities Cost Estimate (PACE) form is available as a fillable Excel file which will perform calculations automatically. Also, construction activity costs should be generally in line with MDOT's most recent Pay Item Code costs.

Surface Transportation Program – Urban (STU) Target

For FY2026, SEMCOG anticipates the STU target to be \$21,724,855. The FAC will set aside 69% (\$14,990,150) to RCOC for county road projects and 31% (\$6,734,705) to Cities and Villages for projects. The Cities and Villages have already approved \$3,446,148 towards projects in FY2026 and there is a remaining balance of \$3,288,557.

For FY2027, the estimated STU target is approximately \$22 million. The FAC will set aside 69% (approximately \$15.2 million) for county road projects, and the remaining 31% (approximately \$6.8 million) for Cities and Villages projects.

For FY2026 and 2027, the total STU funding available is approximately \$10 million for Cities and Villages to prioritize projects based on the 3R project rating worksheets.
