RE: Super Move Permits

Dear Sir/Madam:

A category of permits called Super Move Permits are issued for transporting loads that exceed all other permit parameters. This type of permit covers oversize loads exceeding 16 feet in width (to a maximum of 36 feet), 16 feet in height, and 100 feet in length. This permit is also issued for any load that, because of size, weight or configuration, requires that it be moved at less than posted speed limits. Moves that are approved must take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m., unless otherwise approved.

Enclosed is RCOC Application Form #115. This application should be completed and signed by an authorized agent of the company performing the move. Applications should be submitted a minimum of ten working days in advance of the anticipated move date. A signed route survey is also required at time of application.

The permit fee is \$350 (**U.S. Funds only**) per move which includes two hours of Weighmaster escort time. Additional charges will be applied if the move extends beyond two hours. In the event it is deemed necessary, a RCOC electrical crew may assist on any move at or exceeding 16 feet in height. In the event a RCOC electrical crew is needed, all time and equipment will be charged to the company performing the move (the permit holder) and billed once the move has taken place.

Once an application has been approved, the approval information will be sent to the applicant indicating any additional requirements that are needed. In order for the permit to be issued, an authorized representative of the transporting company must deliver all required documents and fees to the Department of Customer Services - Permit office.

A current certificate of liability of insurance must be provided at the time of permit issuance. Insurance requirements are enclosed.

Please note that it is the responsibility of the applicant to obtain any additional permits or authorizations required by any public or private utility or municipality.
