



## DILL DRIVE RESURFACING EXPECTED TO START THE WEEK OF JULY 6

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Waterford Township, will resurface Dill Dr. from Walton Blvd. to the Oakland Lake DNR public access site. The work is expected to start the week of July 6.

### **PROJECT DETAILS**

The project will include:

- Crushing and shaping the existing pavement and using that material as the base for five-and-a-half inches of new asphalt.
- Drainage improvements along the road.

### **SCHEDULE**

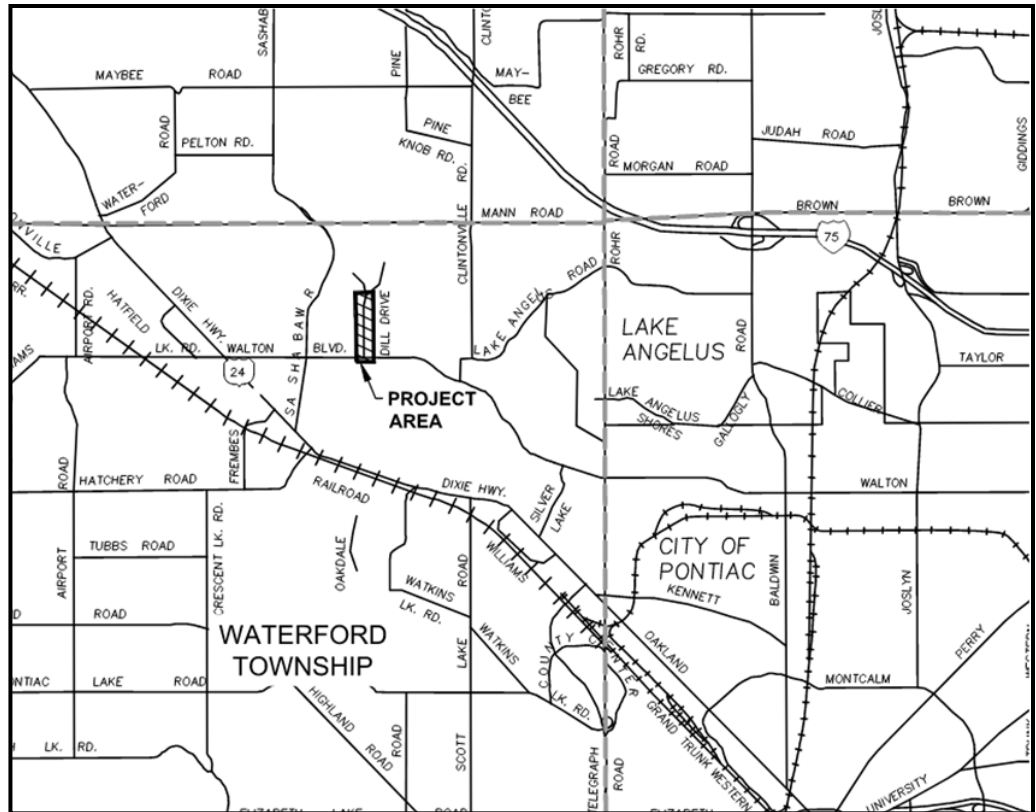
After starting the week of July 6, the project is expected to be completed in late summer.

### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

The road will remain open to two-way traffic throughout construction. However, there may be traffic delays and times when one lane is temporarily closed and flaggers are directing traffic.

### **PROJECT COST AND FUNDING**

The project will cost approximately \$570,000. The



project cost will be shared by RCOC, Waterford Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).

### **CONTRACTOR**

F. Allied Construction, of Clarkston, is the contractor for the project.
