

NORTHBOUND NOVI RD, 8 MILE TO 9 MILE RD, TO CLOSE MARCH 30 FOR CONTINUED CONSTRUCTION

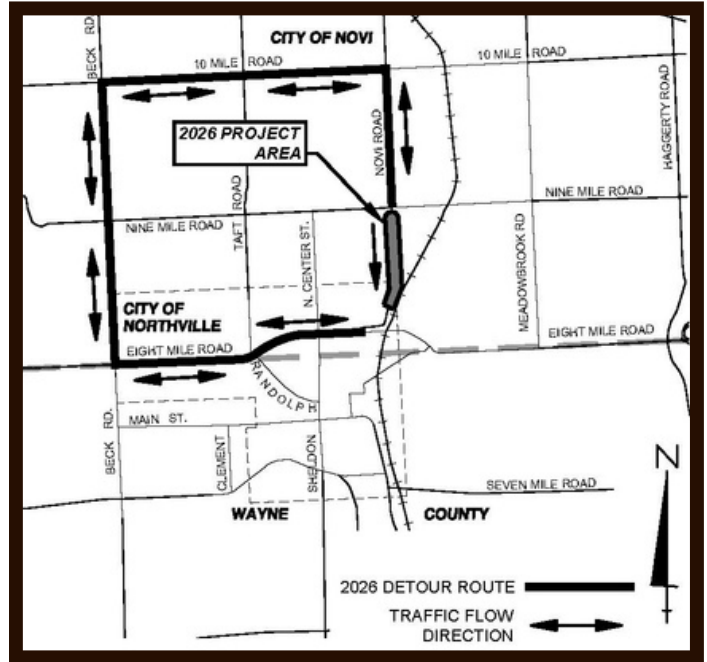
The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with the cities of Novi and Northville, will close northbound Novi Road from 8 Mile Road to 9 Mile Road starting March 30 through late summer for continued resurfacing and safety enhancements.

Southbound Novi Road will remain open to traffic with business access maintained.

PROJECT DETAILS:

The project will include:

- Removal of existing pavement and repaving with two layers of asphalt.
- Adding a continuous center left-turn lane throughout this section of Novi Road.
- Adding two northbound lanes and one southbound lane from the Rouge River/Allen Drive to 9 Mile Road.
- Reconstructing the curve between 8 Mile Road and Allen Road/Rouge River (completed in 2025).
- Replacing curbs and gutters where appropriate.
- Installing storm sewers to improve drainage.
- Upgrades to pedestrian crosswalks to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- Upgrading traffic signs and pavement markings within the project.
- Installation of a **High-Intensity Activated Crosswalk (HAWK)** pedestrian crosswalk beacons just north of Galway Street.



TRAFFIC IMPACT:

Southbound Novi Road will remain open to traffic. Northbound Novi Road will close. The detour is 8 Mile Road to Beck Road to 10 Mile Road, back to Novi Road.

The Wayne County Department of Public Services has closed 8 Mile Road/Base Line Road over the CSX/Lake State Railway tracks between Novi Road and Griswold Street until late summer for bridge rehabilitation work.

PROJECT COST AND FUNDING:

The project cost is approximately \$6.9 million. Eighty percent of the cost will be paid for with federal road funds. The remainder will be shared by the RCOC, Novi, Northville and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
