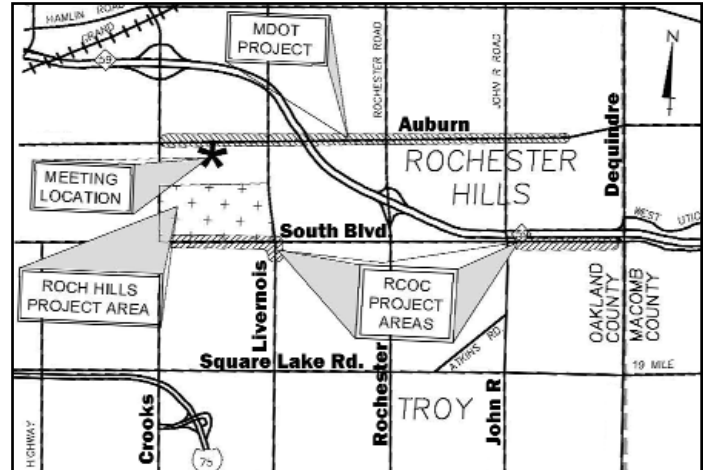


PUBLIC INFO MEETING FOR SOUTH BLVD, AUBURN RD CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS IS APRIL 20

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in cooperation with the City of Rochester Hills, the City of Troy and the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), will conduct a public information meeting Thursday, April 20, from 4 to 6 p.m., about RCOC's upcoming South Blvd. projects, MDOT's Auburn Road project and the City of Rochester Hills' subdivision improvement project.

MEETING DETAILS:

The meeting will be open-house format -- there will not be a formal presentation. Anyone can attend at any time during the meeting to review project plans and/or speak with an RCOC, MDOT or city representative.

RCOC SOUTH BLVD. PROJECT DETAILS

RCOC will resurface South Blvd. between Crooks and Livernois roads and from John R Road to west of Dequindre Road. The Road Commission will also resurface and add northbound, southbound and westbound right-turn lanes to the South Blvd./Livernois intersection as well as install new traffic signals and construct new pedestrian crosswalk ramps.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

During the RCOC projects, South Blvd. will remain open to through traffic, though motorists should expect delays. Alternate routes are advised for those not traveling to or from destinations within the project zone.

RCOC PROJECT SCHEDULE & FUNDING

RCOC's Livernois at South Blvd. intersection project is expected to start this spring and be completed by late summer. It is expected to cost just under \$1 million and is being paid for with federal dollars.

The South Blvd. resurfacing project (Crooks to Livernois and John R to west of Dequindre) is expected to start in mid-

to-late June and be completed by late August. The section between John R and Dequindre will be done first.

The resurfacing of South Blvd. is expected to cost \$1.8 million, with the cost shared by RCOC, the cities of Rochester Hills and Troy and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).

MDOT AUBURN ROAD PROJECT

Also this year, MDOT will widen Auburn between Crooks and Livernois roads, adding a continuous center left-turn lane. MDOT will also add some right-turn lanes and make intersection improvements at locations along Auburn between Crooks and Culbertson Street.

ROCHESTER HILLS PROJECTS

Additionally, during the 2017 construction season, the City of Rochester Hills will replace water mains and resurface the roads within the following nearby subdivisions: Belle Cone Gardens, Homestead Acres and Sunnysdale Gardens.

If you wish to attend the meeting and require special accommodation in accordance with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) or Title VI, including those requiring language assistance, RCOC will provide such services, free of charge, with reasonable advance notice (seven business days).
