

PUBLIC INFO MEETING IS DEC. 6 FOR TRIPP ROAD RECONSTRUCTION, DIXIE HIGHWAY TO VAN

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in cooperation with the Charter Township of Groveland, will conduct a public information meeting Wednesday, Dec. 6, about the reconstruction next year of Tripp Road from Dixie Highway to Van Road.

MEETING DETAILS:

WHEN: Wednesday, Dec., 6, 2017, 4-7 p.m.

WHERE: Groveland Twp. Fire Department, 14645 Dixie Highway (at Grange Hall Road) Groveland Twp., MI 48442

The meeting will be open-house format -- there will not be a formal presentation, but anyone can attend at any time during the meeting to review project plans and/or speak with an RCOC representative.

PROJECT DETAILS:

The project involves the complete reconstruction of this one-mile section of Tripp Road. This will include widening the shoulders, the installation of curbs and gutters and the construction of storm sewers. Also included will be the replacement of the culvert that carries the Thread Creek under the road.


Tree debris along the road will be removed by the contractor when the project starts.

The project will provide a smooth new surface, safer shoulders and improved drainage.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC:

The road will be **closed to through traffic throughout the project**. The detour route will be Dixie Highway to Grange Hall Road, back to Tripp Road and vice versa. Access will be maintained to homes and businesses within the project at all times.

PROJECT SCHEDULE & FUNDING:

Work is expected to begin in the summer of 2018 and be completed in the fall.

The project is expected to cost approximately \$2.3 million. Eighty percent of the cost of the project will be paid for with federal funding. The remainder will be shared by the Road Commission, Groveland Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).
