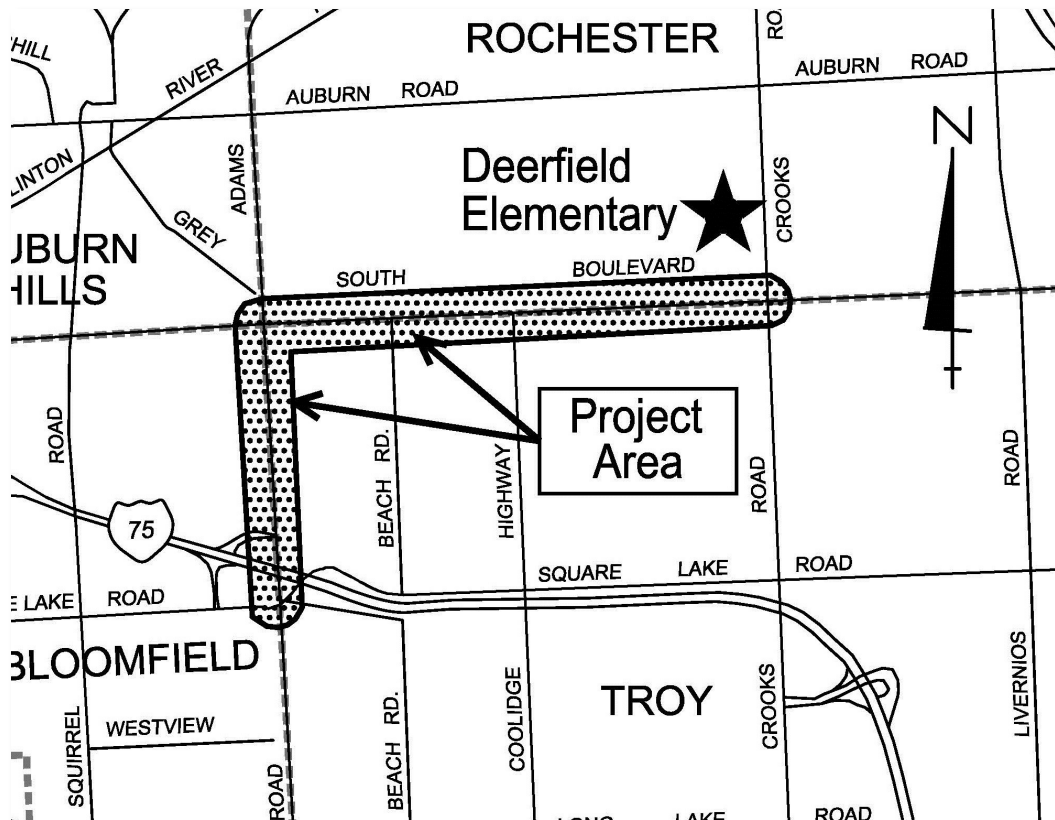


PROJECT INFORMATION FOR 2018

ADAMS ROAD RESURFACING



PROJECT DETAILS

The Adams Road project includes the section from South Blvd. to Square Lake Road and involves sealing the existing road surface followed by the application of three inches of new asphalt as well as drainage improvements, shoulder widening and traffic signal upgrades.

SCHEDULE AND IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

The project is expected to begin in mid-to-late July. From the project start until approximately Aug. 8, two-way traffic will be maintained. From Aug. 8 to the project completion, Adams Road will be reduced to one lane of northbound traffic only between the I-75 ramps and South Boulevard. The detour route for southbound traffic will be South Boulevard to Squirrel Road to Square Lake Road and back to Adams.

The road is expected to be re-opened to two-way traffic by the end of October. Access to homes and businesses along this section of Adams Road will be maintained at all times during the project.

FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$2.1 million. Of this amount, \$1.7 million will be paid for with federal funds. The remainder will be funded by the Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC).
