



PROJECT INFORMATION FOR 2018 TRIPP ROAD RECONSTRUCTION



PROJECT DETAILS:

The project involves the complete reconstruction of Tripp Road between Van Road and Dixie Hwy. This will include widening the shoulders, the installation of curbs and gutters and the construction of storm sewers. Also included will be the replacement of the culvert that carries the Thread Creek under the road. Tree debris along the road will be removed by the contractor when the project starts. The project will provide a smooth new surface, safer shoulders and improved drainage.

PROJECT SCHEDULE & FUNDING:

Work is expected to begin in the summer of 2018 and be completed in the fall.

The project is expected to cost approximately \$2.3 million. Eighty percent of the cost of the project will be paid for with federal funding. The remainder will be shared by Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), Groveland Township and Oakland County general government (through the Tri-Party Program).

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC:

The road will be closed to through traffic throughout the project. The detour route will be Dixie Highway to Grange Hall Road, back to Tripp Road and vice versa. Access will be maintained to homes and businesses within the project at all times.
