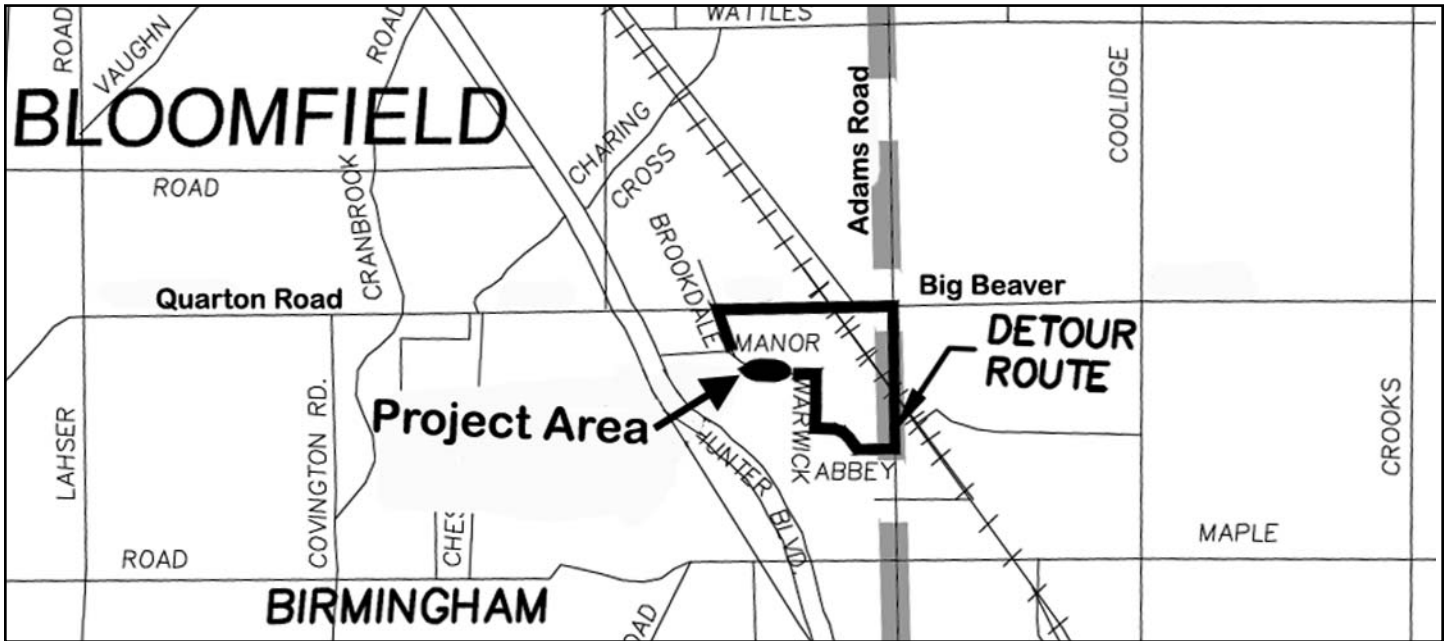


## MANOR ROAD BRIDGE MAINTENANCE PROJECT TO START IN LATE AUGUST



The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) will close the Manor Road bridge over the Rouge River in Bloomfield Township for two weeks starting in late August to conduct preventative maintenance on the structure.

### **PROJECT DETAILS**

The project involves waterproofing the bridge deck and then resurfacing the deck with asphalt. It also includes minor repairs to the bridge barrier walls as well.

### **SCHEDULE AND**

#### **IMPACT ON TRAFFIC**

The bridge will be closed during the work, which is expected to take two weeks. The closure will not occur until sometime after the Aug. 20 Woodward Dream Cruise, though an

exact start date has not yet been identified.

During the closure, the detour route for Manor Street traffic will be Brookdale Street to Big Beaver Road to Adams Road to Abbey Street to Warwick Street back to Manor and vice versa.

### **FUNDING**

The project is expected to cost approximately \$104,000. It is to be paid for with Michigan Local Bridge Program dollars as well as funds from the Road Commission.
