

ORION/FLINT/MILLER ROUNDABOUT PROJECT TO START AFTER SEPT. 10

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Orion Township and the Village of Lake Orion, will begin construction on a compact roundabout at the Orion Road/Flint Street/Miller Street intersection on the Lake Orion/Orion Township border after Sept. 10.

PROJECT DETAILS

In addition to constructing a compact roundabout at the Orion/Flint/Miller intersection, the project also includes:

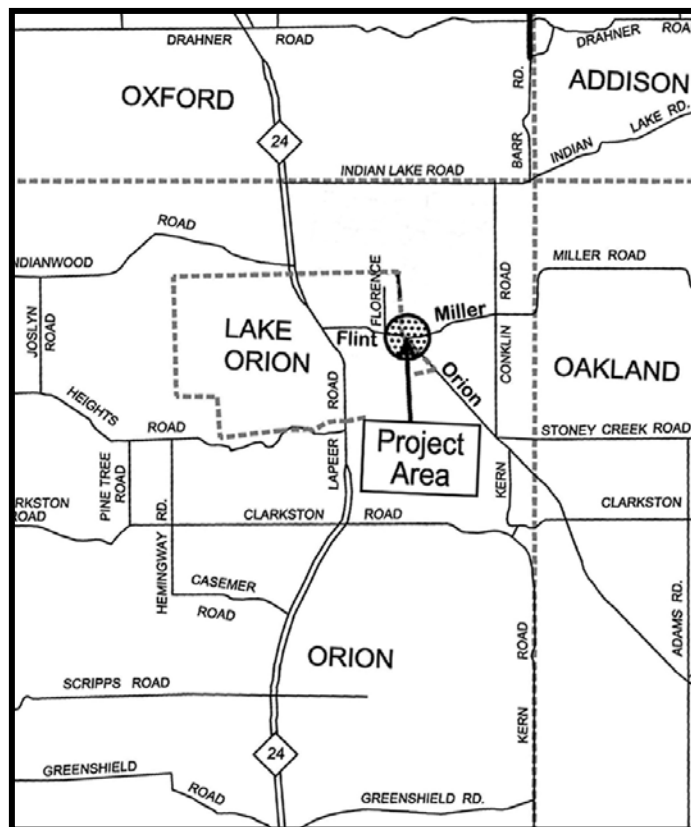
- Improvements to pedestrian pathways
- Construction of raised pedestrian crosswalks at the approaches to the roundabout
- Reconstruction of the Flint Street, Miller Street and Orion Road approaches to the roundabout
- Minor storm-sewer improvements

SCHEDULE & IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

The project is expected to start after Sept. 10. It is expected to be completed by the end of October.

The intersection will be completely closed during the roundabout construction. While the intersection is closed, the following detour routes will be in place.

- The detour for **eastbound or westbound Flint / Miller streets traffic** is Flint Road to Lapeer Road (M-24) to Atwater Road to Orion Road to Conklin Road to Miller Road and vice versa.
- The detour for **northbound Orion Road traffic needing to access Flint Road or Flint Road traffic needed to access southbound Orion Road** is Orion Road to Atwater Road to Lapeer Road (M-24) to Flint Road and vice versa.



- The detour for **northbound Orion Road traffic needing to access Miller Road or Miller traffic needed to access southbound Orion Road** is Orion Road to Conklin Road to Miller Road and vice versa.

FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$600,000.
