

SASHABAW ROAD CONSTRUCTION, I-75 TO SOUTH OF CLARKSTON ROAD, TO TAKE PLACE IN 2018 AND 2019

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Independence Township, will widen and reconstruct Sashabaw Road from I-75 to south of Clarkston Road.

PROJECT DETAILS

The project will involve:

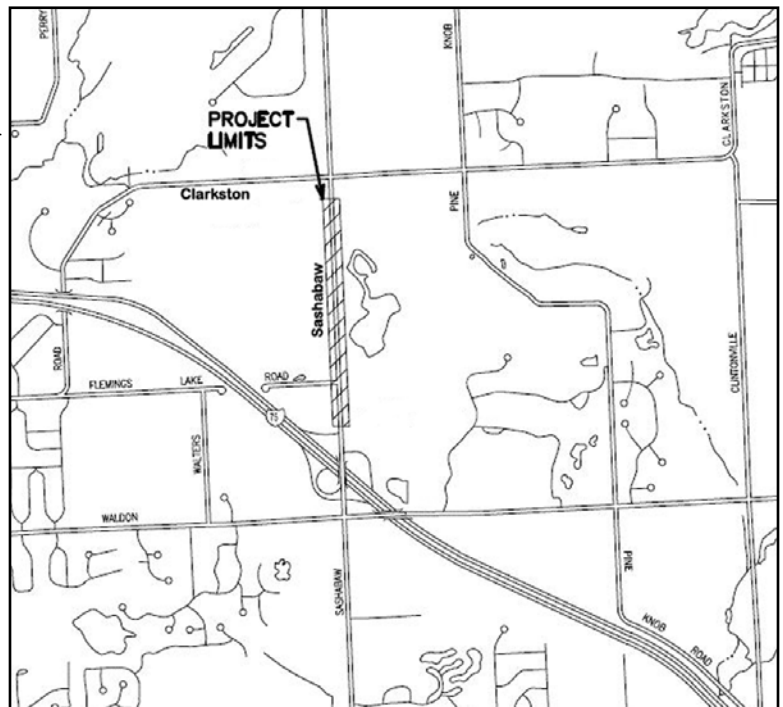
- Widening and resurfacing the road. Once complete, the road will include two through lanes in each direction and a center turn lane.
- The road will include asphalt pavement with concrete curbs and gutters.
- Dedicated right-turn lanes will be installed where warranted.
- Sidewalks will be constructed with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant pedestrian crosswalks.
- Sanitary sewers and new water-main leads will be installed.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

There will be lane closures, but a minimum of one lane in each direction will be maintained at all times.

SCHEDULE

Sanitary sewer work will take place in fall 2018, but will be outside of the roadway. There will be temporary lane closures at times. Major road construction will begin in the spring of 2019 and be completed by the fall.



FUNDING

This project is expected to cost approximately \$4.8 million. The majority of the cost will be paid for by Independence Township, with RCOC and Oakland County general government paying the remainder through the Tri-Party Program.
