

RE: Seasonal Public Utility/Agricultural Non-Emergency Exemption Move Permits

Dear Sir/Madam:

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) issues Seasonal Public Utility Non-Emergency Move Permits for oversize/overweight loads that need to be transported by utility companies or their sub-contractors during Spring Weight Restriction/Frost Law implementation time. This is based on the Seasonal Utility Emergency Notification Law, Public Act 300: Section 257.722.

Enclosed is a RCOC Application form for a Seasonal Public Utility / Agricultural Non-Emergency Exemption Permit. This application should be completed and signed by an authorized agent of the utility company or sub-contractor performing the moves. Applications should be submitted by mail with a \$100.00 (U.S. Funds only) permit fee for each truck-tractor/trailer combination that a permit is being requested for. If submitting application via fax to 248-858-4773 or by email to permits@rcoc.org, the permit fee can follow by mail or payment can be made by phone with a Credit/Debit Card payment. Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express are accepted and include an Enhanced Access Fee.

Once an application has been approved and a permit number assigned to each truck-tractor/trailer combination, we will return a copy of the permit back to the applicant. A Route Notification Application form, which is enclosed for your reference, will be included with the permit paperwork for future use. A Route Notification Application is to be submitted at least 24 hours in advance of a requested move referencing the permit number assigned to it. These notifications are accepted by fax at (248) 858-4773 or by e-mail to permits@rcoc.org. After all information has been verified and the move is approved, the Route Notification Application form will be returned to the applicant.

Seasonal Public Utility Non-Emergency Move Permits can also now be obtained by using the OXCART Permit System at www.oxcartpermits.com.

A current certificate of liability of insurance must be provided at the time of permit application. Insurance requirements are enclosed.

In the event of an emergency a written notification from the utility company must be received via fax or email within 24 hours of said emergency. In the event the emergency move needs to take place during non-business hours, please contact our Dispatch office at (248) 858-4895.
