RE: Agricultural Exemption Move Permits

Dear Sir/Madam:

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) issues Seasonal Agricultural Permits for oversize/overweight loads that need to be transported by companies for the purpose of making an agricultural delivery during Spring Weight Restriction/Frost Law implementation time. This is based on the Seasonal Utility Emergency Notification Law. Public Act 300: Section 257.722.

Enclosed is a RCOC Application form for a Seasonal Public Utility / Agricultural Non-Emergency Exemption Permit. This application should be completed and signed by an authorized agent of the agricultural commodities delivery company. Applications may be submitted by fax to (248) 858-4773, emailed to permits@rcoc.org, hand delivered, or sent via postal mail.

Once an application has been approved and a permit number assigned to each truck-tractor/trailer combination, we will return a copy of the permit back to the applicant. A Route Notification Application form, which is enclosed for your reference, will also be included with the permit paperwork for future use.

A Route Notification Application is to be submitted at least 24 hours in advance of a requested move referencing the permit number assigned to it. These notifications are accepted by fax to 248-858-4773 or by e-mail to permits@rcoc.org. After all information has been verified and the move is approved, the Route Notification Application form will be returned to the applicant.

Seasonal Agricultural Permits can also now be obtained by using the OXCART Permit System at www.oxcartpermits.com.
