

INFO MEETING IS DEC. 12 FOR 2019 GRASS LAKE RD. PAVING IN WHITE LAKE TWP. TWP.

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with White Lake Township, will host a public information meeting Wednesday, Dec. 12, to share information about the planned 2019 paving of Grass Lake Road between Ormond and Steeple Hill roads.

MEETING DETAILS

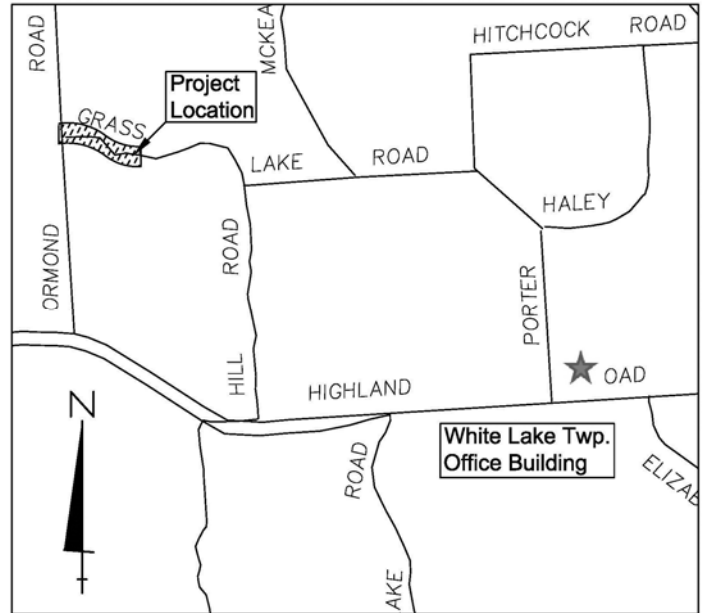
WHAT: Public information meeting to discuss the construction plans and the impact on traffic during construction.

WHEN: Wednesday, Dec. 12, 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.

NOTE: The meeting will be “open house” format.

There will not be a formal presentation. Anyone can attend any time from 4-7 p.m. to review information and speak with an RCOC representative.



PROJECT DETAILS

This project involves the 2019 paving of this gravel section of Grass Lake Road. It will include concrete curbs and gutters and improved roadway drainage and alignment.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC AND SCHEDULE

During construction, Grass Lake Road between Ormond and Steeple Hill roads will be closed to through traffic. Local traffic will be allowed to access homes within the construction zone at all times.

The detour route for Grass Lake Road through traffic will be Ormond Road to Highland Road to Hill Road and back to Grass Lake Road and vice versa.

Work is expected to start on the project in spring 2019 and be completed in fall.

FUNDING

The estimated project cost is \$1.5 million. It will be paid for with a state grant and funding from White Lake Township.
