

PUBLIC INFO MEETING IS TUESDAY, FEB. 25, FOR NORTH HOLLY RESURFACING PROJECT

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Holly Township, will host a public information meeting Tuesday, Feb. 25, to share information about the project to resurface North Holly Road from Grange Hall Road to the county line. The work

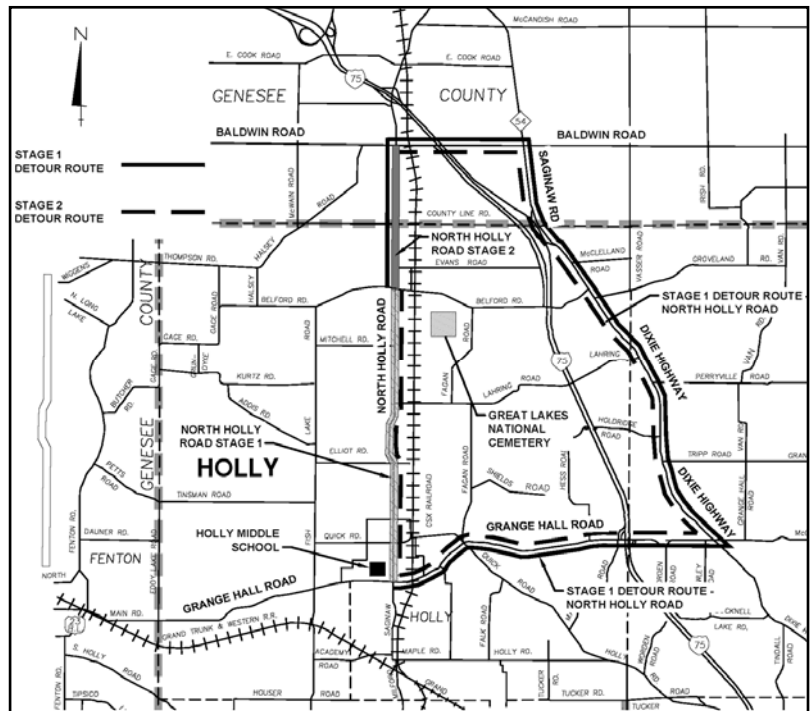
MEETING DETAILS

WHAT: Public information meeting to discuss the construction plans and the impact on traffic during construction.

WHEN: Tuesday, Feb. 25, 2020

WHERE: Holly Middle School, 14470 N. Holly Road, Holly, MI 48442

NOTE: The meeting will be “open house” format. There will not be a formal presentation. Anyone can attend any time between 4-7 p.m. to review information and speak with an RCOC representative.



PROJECT DETAILS

The project involves 4.5 miles of asphalt resurfacing. It will start in June and be completed in the fall. In addition to the resurfacing, the project includes:

- Complete reconstruction of the road in three locations and raising the elevation of the road in those locations to improve drainage.
- Reconstruction of the retaining wall and hill adjustments at the intersection of North Holly Road and Belford Road to improve sight distances.
- Other safety improvements include high-friction surface treatment at significant curves, guardrail installation and culvert maintenance at the Swartz Creek.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

The project will be constructed in two stages. During each stage, that portion of North Holly Road will be closed to through traffic. Local traffic traveling to and from homes and businesses within the closures will be

permitted during the closures.

Stage 1 is the section of North Holly Road from north of Grange Hall Road to Belford Road. This section will be under construction and closed to through traffic in the summer of 2020.

Stage 2 is the section of North Holly Road from Belford Road to the county line. This section will be under construction and closed to through traffic in the late summer and fall of 2020.

FUNDING

The project is expected to cost approximately \$4.3 million. A special federal grant will cover \$3 million with the remainder shared by RCOC and Holly Township.
