

PUBLIC INFO MEETING WILL BE SEPT. 14 FOR NAPIER ROAD PAVING PROJECT, 9 MILE TO 10 MILE

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC) will conduct a public information meeting Wednesday, Sept. 14, about the 2017 project to pave Napier Road between 9 Mile and 10 Mile roads on the Lyon Township/Novi border.

Here are the details:

FORMAT: This meeting will be **open-house format**. There will not be any formal presentations, but anyone can attend at any time to speak with an RCOC representative.

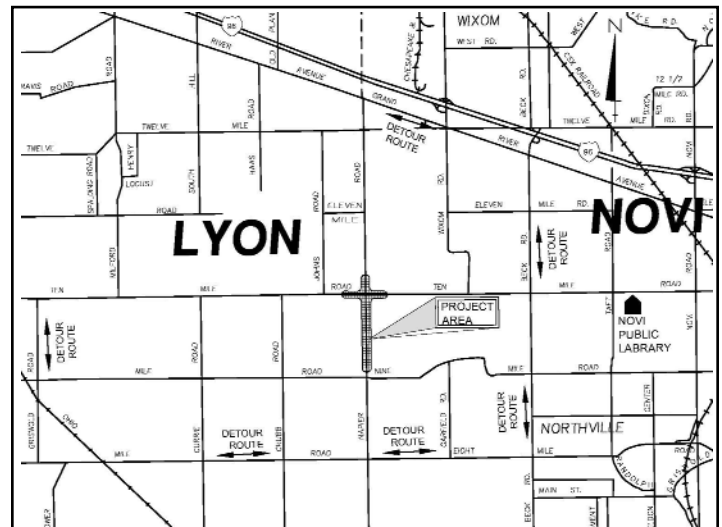
PROJECT DETAILS:

RCOC will pave the currently gravel section of Napier Road from 9 Mile Road to north of Turnberry Dr. north of 10 Mile. The project includes reconstructing the 10 Mile/Napier intersection as a roundabout and reconstructing 10 Mile Road from Copperwood Drive to west of Napavine Drive.

Napier Road will be constructed as an asphalt road. It will have paved shoulders and ditches in places and curb and gutter in other places. Storm water management will be improved, and guardrail will be included where appropriate.

IMPACT ON TRAFFIC

Both Napier and 10 Mile roads will be closed during the project. Access to all homes and businesses within the construction area will be maintained at all times, though the road will be closed to through traffic.



During the project, the following **detour routes** will be in place:

- For **10 Mile:** Griswold Road to Eight Mile Road to Beck Road and back to 10 Mile and vice versa.
- For **Napier:** Grand River Ave. to Beck Road to 8 Mile Road and back to Napier and vice versa.

Note: These detours are the suggested routes for through traffic and trucks. Individual drivers may choose an alternate route.

SCHEDULE:

START:Spring 2017

OPEN TO TRAFFIC:Fall 2017

COST/FUNDING

The project is expected to cost approximately \$5 million and will be funded through a combination of federal and local dollars.
