

MALONEY AVE. BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT PLANNED FOR 2022

The Road Commission for Oakland County (RCOC), in partnership with Oxford Township, will replace the Maloney Avenue bridge over Long Lake/Clear Lake in 2022.

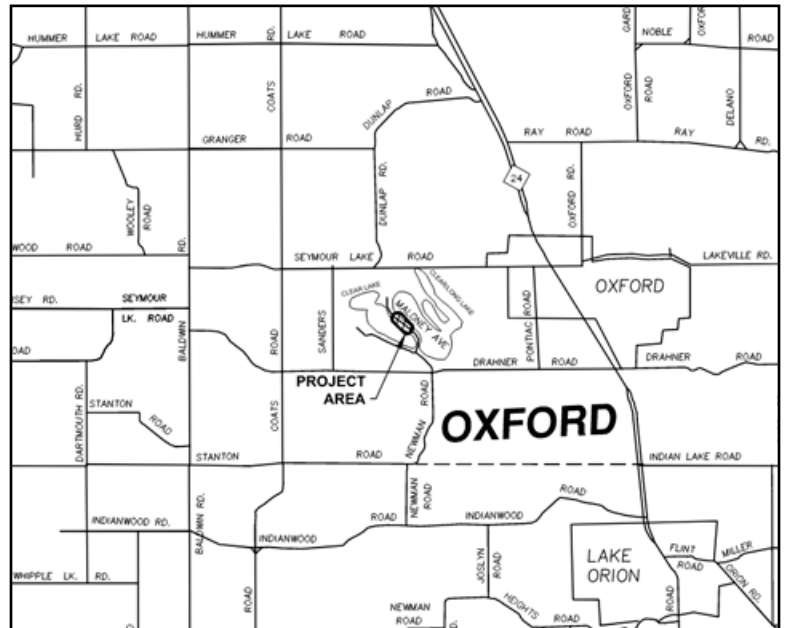
PROJECT DETAILS

The project includes:

- Replacement of the Maloney bridge over Long Lake/Clear Lake
- Reconstruction of one-tenth of a mile of Maloney Ave. with asphalt pavement (work will extend 300 feet north and south of bridge)
- Upgrading of guardrails and traffic signs
- The road will be closed at the bridge during construction, but access to all homes will be maintained via a single-lane temporary road

SCHEDULE

- **Utility relocation:** Winter and spring of 2022
- **Minor tree removal:** March 2022
- **Construction starts:** Late spring 2022
- **Project completion:** Fall 2022



BRIDGE WEIGHT POSTING

On Sept. 9, the RCOC Board further reduced the allowable weight of vehicles using the bridge to nine tons due to the increasingly deteriorated condition of the bridge. This restriction prohibits school buses, fire trucks (except for emergencies), garbage trucks and delivery trucks from using the bridge.

PROJECT COST AND FUNDING

The project is expected to cost \$2 million. It is being paid for with federal funds and RCOC dollars.
